

Integrate the Institute of Chemical Research through the EMERGIA Program of the Andalusian Government

The Andalusian Government has launched the EMERGIA program for recruiting talented scientists. The Program, co-financed by the Spanish Research Council (CSIC), consists in a 4 years contract with a salary of 38000€/year, plus a research grant of up to 160.000€ (<http://www.d-andalucia.csic.es/es/noticia/Emergia>). The Institute for Chemical Research (IIQ), as receiving center, offers new and equipped laboratories for the recruited scientist to develop their own research.

The Institute belongs to the Spanish Research Council and the University of Seville and is located at the Cartuja Island not far from beautiful historic center of Seville.
